What we are Doing

Missionary Outpost Center

We are equipping and training pastors to engage within the 10/40 Window, which encompasses Northern Africa, China, India, Nepal, and Japan, with the aim of spreading the gospel. With over 3 billion individuals still unaware of God's love (as referenced in John 3:16), this initiative is of paramount importance. The total projected cost for this project is \$800,000 (USD).

Phase 1

This is becoming a reality. We have purchased land (1.8 acres), have gotten the land surveyed and the blueprints drawn. Now we are at the next phase clearing the land, getting the electricity to the land, putting the plumbing and water system, latrines put in place and fence around the property. The cost of Phase 1 is \$125,000.

Location: Mbale, Uganda, Africa.

Phase 2

The foundation of both the living facility and the training center will be erected. This building will be three-story, that will have the capacity for 40+ rooms. This phase will be building the steel frame and pouring the concrete. Also building out the façade, roofing, doors and windows installed. With a dining room restaurant on the first floor. This cost will be \$375,000



Phase 3

The Training Center being built will seat 500 Pastor's and Church Leaders. This phase will complete the building project with the furnishings of the three offices and training center seating and furnishings. This will be the laughing pad for these leaders to take the Gospel to the world with the emphasis on reaching the unreached. The Mission Outpost Center will be completed in 2025. This final cost will be \$300,000.

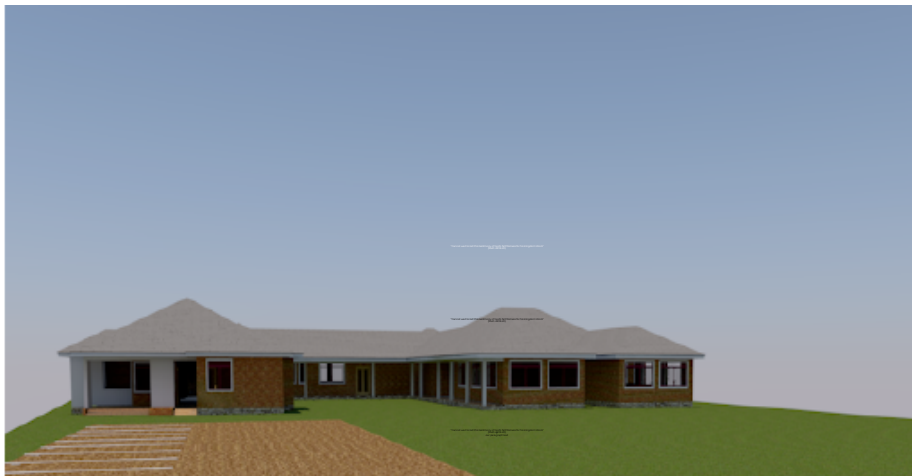

Plans for the Clinic and 50 Bed Hospital

We had just celebrated 20 years of doing Mission work in Uganda (2003-2023). We were approached to purchase 1.5 acres behind the Missionary Outpost Center property. Our highest priority of the use of the land for the DOKO Community is a Clinic and 50 bed Hospital. Because the closet medical facility is 6 miles away. If a pregnant Woman does not have a Midwife in the village. When she is ready to deliver and has complications, they can lose the baby, or the mother may die or both may die. We would have a clinic and hospital with Midwives and Doctor's at this facility. This project will cost \$502,00. USD.

PHASE 1

Land

We have successfully acquired 1.5 acres of land and completed the survey. Next steps include testing the soil, clearing and leveling the land, as well as positioning the three essential systems: electrical, plumbing, and water. The total estimated cost for these tasks is \$100,000.

PHASE 2

Develop

The project involves purchasing cement and building materials, as well as laying the cement foundation and constructing the steel framing of the building. Additionally, concrete flooring and wall structures will be established. This includes buying and installing windows, flooring, doors, and finishing with the façade and roof. The total cost for these activities will amount to \$300,000.

PHASE 3

Occupation

Installing parking lots for staff, visitors and patients. Creating a decorated space for the patients and furnishings for their rooms. And accommodations for doctors and nurses. Also to ensure that the Building Management System is working well. So that all the staff, nurses and doctors, will be trained with an operational manual. This will cost \$102,000.

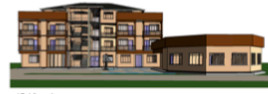
